

C. We have written to him advising that in the absence of any names or identification marks on the chattels removed from the above address, all goods were sold at public auction in the name of the owner of the house and that you have informed us that you will make direct settlement with him regarding his share of the chattel proceeds. Before releasing to you the small balance standing to your credit with the Custodian we wish to have on file a letter from Mr. and Mrs. Makebayashi confirming that they agree to settlement being made direct between you in connection with their share of the chattel proceeds, and we have written them in this regard today. I believe Mr. Omiya has been instructed by your office to contact me with regards to the claim he has made for the chattels that were auctioned along with mine.


