





And what happen to the late Masakichi MIYASAKI's Estate liquid assessed.

In her letter she mention that she's getting \$12.00 a month. And even for the ordinary maintenance, the rest of people had increase of 10% but Mrs. Asayo MIYASAKI wouldn't get her increase. I also like to hear all the misunderstanding of everything.

Food, clothing and home uses etc. are very expensive, so she's very hard on \$12.00 a month. Will you kindly help her out, and send her \$25.00 per month to Mrs. Asayo MIYASAKI, 45 Elm Avenue, Lemon Creek, Sloan, B. C.

The late Mr. Masakichi MIYASAKI Estate was equal to four of us. Mrs. Asayo MIYASAKI, Masaburo MIYASAKI, Masoru MIYASAKI and Mitsue MIYASAKI. Please let me know immediately how many hundred dollars was equal to every one of us.

I am here in Alberta, but no work will suit me here and very hard to live on so kindly send me all the money I own. My address,
