

Japanese in question.

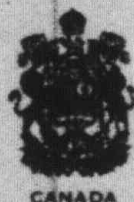
