Dear Madam:-

We are in receipt of yours of the 23rd ultimo with list of articles said to have been stored by you at 285 Bentley Avenue, formerly owned by H. TAKASHIMA.

In reply we wish to state that our records show that you declared on the 8th May 1942 as follows:-

"I certify that the above information is true and complete and state that I have no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area in British Columbia".

You signed this statement and it is on file.

In view of this and the fact that we have had no inquiry from you in respect to any chattels in Vancouver for over five years, we have no separate record of any in your name.

As you left these with Mr. TAKASHIMA at 285 Bentley Avenue and as the chattels there were dealt with in his name, either being sold or moved to Crane Storage Co. warehouse, and as he has assumed responsibility of any such as were dealt with in this manner, we suggest that having left yours in his care, that you look to him for such consideration as you are entitled to.

You say that he states that he has "no information about it", which statement is hardly in accordance with the facts, as he has received reports of sales and the chattels at Crane's, of which he has a list, are presently subject to his order.
