Dear Mr. McAlister:-

Thank you for your letter referring to my bill against Mr. Yasushi SAITO, formerly of Fife Bay, B. C. File No. 12814 and 311 and 8347.

I made out the bill against Yasushi SAITO, because he was the patient whom I looked after some six or seven years ago when he was a mere lad. Of course his parents are responsible for the payment of the bill because he is a minor. I believe their names are:-

Mr. and Mrs. Mataju SAITO

Yasushi was their only son then, and he had a bad case of peritonitis following ruptured appendix. He was operated upon at the Vancouver General Hospital and it was a miracle that he survived. This bill is the balance which they have failed to pay me so far.

I have your letters regarding some others whom you have been unable to locate, but I am afraid I cannot help you much, as I am just as ignorant about their whereabouts as you are, since their evacuation.
