A claim for \$9.90 was filed against Nachi MIYAHARA by Frederick Field & Co. on behalf of M. Ebisuzaki & Co. This claim was paid on December 20, 1945, at the request of her husband, Sigmund MIYAHARA, File 4020, from funds to his credit with this office.
