

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 7, 1942, in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind left in the protected area.

However, a fishing vessel, licensed in the name of this man, was in custody. This vessel was sold by the Custodian for the net sum of \$29.21, which was credited to his account. The expenses charged on this vessel were \$6.79 proportionate share of the general boat expenses, and \$12.00 for repairs paid to C. E. Godard.
