



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above, who registered with the Custodian on May 7/42 and was evacuated Sept. 12/42, stated that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia, and none was found to belong to him.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: The above surrendered to the R.C.M.P. on Feb. 20/42, the following articles:

- 1 De Forest Crossley radio
- 1 Kodak Brownie Hawkeye No. 2

The radio and camera were delivered to the Custodian on June 16/44. The radio was sold at auction on April 4/45 for the net sum of \$47.67, and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian. The camera was mailed to Mr. SAIGA on Feb. 4/46. Owing to the wording of the original receipt given to SAIGA by the R.C.M.P. it would appear that they signed for 2 cameras. On investigation however this proved incorrect as only one camera was received by the R.C.M.P., and this was fully explained in our letter to SAIGA of April 5/46.

LIFE INSURANCE: The above did not declare any life insurance, but on Aug. 9/44 the Monarch Life Assurance Co. sent us a cash surrender value cheque in favour of SAIGA in the sum of \$534.58 for policy No. 73960. This cheque was remitted to SAIGA as per our letter of Aug. 9/44.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
