The radio and camera were delivered to the Custodian on June 16/44. The radio was sold at auction on April 4/55 for the net sum of \$47.67, and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian. The camera was mailed to Mr. SAIGA on Feb. 4/46. Owing to the wording of the original receipt given to SAIGA by the A.C.M.P. it would appear that they signed for 2 cameras.
