We acknowledge with thanks your letter of August 5, 1949. We cannot gather from your letter whether the policy will carry itself to maturity and if so, the value it will have at that time, and would appreciate being advised.

With reference to the existence of the Assured, we will be pleased to know whether you have had any recent communication with him. If not, his mother, Mrs. Tame Yoshida, New Denver, B.C., his only known living relative in Canada, might be able to give you some information in this regard. Our file indicates that Kichi Yoshida's father died at Tachme, B. C. on April 11, 1944.

Kichi Yoshida was born in Japan and appears to have been in Japan prior to the outbreak of war with that country. As suggested to your Mr. Irvine in a telephone conversation this morning, you might write to the External Affairs Department at Ottawa for directions concerning how the assured may be located.
