1. That I owned a Brownie Camera, Size 116, and have personal knowledge of the facts herein declared.
2. That I had in my possession and control at Coghlan, B.C. a Brownie Camera.
3. On the 22nd September, 1942, I delivered the said camera to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, and obtained a receipt therefor.
4. That I have made a most diligent search for the said receipt in all repositories where such receipt might be. I have not found the same and verily believe that the said receipt has been lost beyond recovery and destroyed.
5. That I have not in any way dealt with the said receipt or papers relating to the said camera, and have not pledged or hypothecated the same or lodged the receipt with any person, firm or corporation as security.
6. That the sole reason for the non-production of the receipt is that it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.

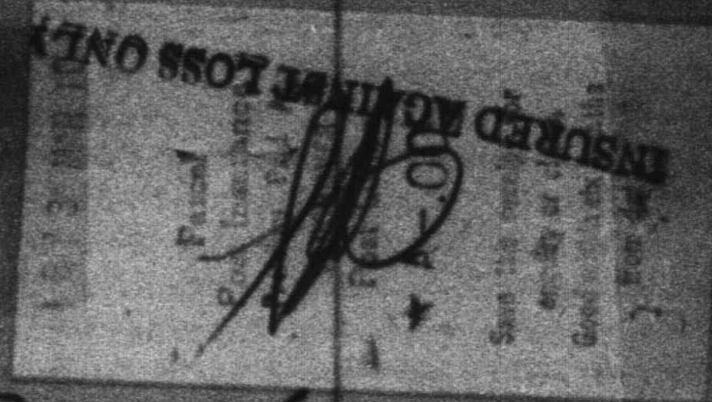
