The above, who registered with the Custodian on May 8th, 1942, and was evacuated on May 11th, 1942, stated that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. No chattels were found by the Custodian belonging to him.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: Although he declared no goods whatsoever, a General Electric radio which he had handed to the R.C.M.P. on March 11th, 1942, was handed over by them to the Custodian on June 20th, 1944, and sold at auction for the net sum of \$47.00, and this amount credited to his account. Full details of this given on the Specified Articles Summary on file. This is his total balance with the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Your file has been reviewed and the following is noted.

When you registered with the Custodian on May 8th, 1944, you stated that you owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. However, on June 20th, 1944, a radio which you had surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, was handed over by them to the Custodian. This radio was sold at auction for the net sum of \$47.00, and the proceeds credited to your account. We now enclose Custodian cheque in your favour in this amount.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
