We are enclosing herewith copy of the B. C. Security Commission's letter of June 12th and one copy of Custodian Release Forms calling for shipment of various effects stored with you in the name of Rense Suzumoto but in part the property of the other Japanese whose names are shown at the head of this letter.

While there is no objection to shipment going forward, please particularly note that this should not be done until you receive word from Mr. Fisher of the B. C. Security Commission that funds have been received to cover charges. You should also, of course, be fully covered as to your own storage charges before shipment is made.

We are not quite sure what this will leave in storage after shipment is made. Apparently Parcels 17, 18, 19 and 20 were shipped in September 1942. In this case, after shipment of the items asked for in our enclosure, there will only be Parcels 21, 22 and 23 left with you. In saying this, we are assuming that the roll of carpet asked for by Rense Suzumoto is No. 14.

You might let us know about this in due course and meanwhile if it is not clear to you exactly what is required, please advise and we will investigate further.
