GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Mary (Mrs. Kunajiro) ADACHI - 14299

November 15, 1946.

Mrs. Ogen ADACHI made a declaration on May 11th, 1942, and included in her JP form a list of effects stated as being in the dwelling at Port Moody. Her husband however, also declared the family effects, although only briefly, (Kunajiro ADACHI, file 7251) and owing to the possibility of vandalism, all the goods found in the dwelling were removed by the Custodian agents to storage in New Westminster.

An inventory of these was sent to Mr. & Mrs. ADACHI on August 31st, 1942, and was confirmed by Kunajiro ADACHI.

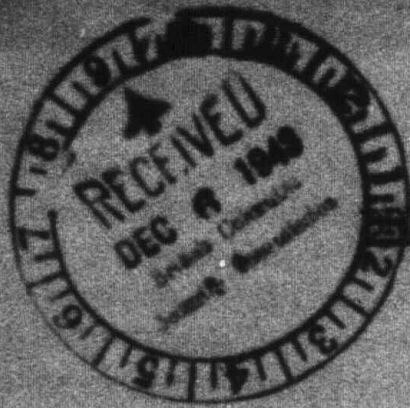
All the effects concerned, ^{except those shipped to Ogen Adachi} were sold at auction and the proceeds realized credited to Kunajiro ADACHI'S account (file 7251). Full particulars are given on that file.
