GENERAL SUMMARY

Tokue MINAMIDE died at New Denver on September 5, 1945. She is survived by her husband Masajiro, file #5162, a daughter, Toshiko (Mrs. Mineichi) MINAMIDE, file #8950, and an adopted son, Mineichi MINAMIDE, file #14776, who is also her son-in-law, being married to her daughter Toshiko.

The only asset declared by Tokue MINAMIDE was an account in the amount of \$229.00 in the Bank of Montreal, Main & Hastings, Vancouver, B. C. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The only claim filed against the deceased was for the sum of \$80.00 claimed by the Department of Labour to reimburse the Department for expenses incurred by them for her funeral. This claim was referred to her husband, Masajiro on October 18, 1945, and paid from his account on January 7, 1946.

No claims, other than that mentioned above, appear on this file.
