This file reveals that Mrs. NISHIOKA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. NISHIOKA made her declaration to the Custodian on May 11/42 and was evacuated on June 1/42. She declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule on file at the Continental Daily News, 213-215 E. Cordova St.
Goods removed from this address in the name of Mrs. NISHIOKA were sold at auction for the net sum of \$7.95 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian.
The following goods were not found by the Custodian:

3 boxes Japanese figures	2 beds	1 chest of drawers
1 box of books	1 baby bed	

I have checked the files of those who left goods at the Continental Daily News and cannot find any articles similar to these which may have been incorrectly credited. Shipments were made to the various Japanese from 213-215 E. Cordova St. by Mr. IWASAKI and Mr. A. H. Young, who had the keys to this building. No record was kept of these shipments so it is possible that the goods declared by Mrs. NISHIOKA which we have not found, may have been shipped to her.
