We acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 13th December last.

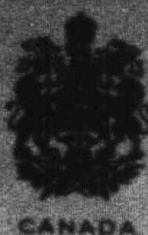

3. I should appreciate it if you could inform me as to the steps necessary. (Phone ALma 3044)

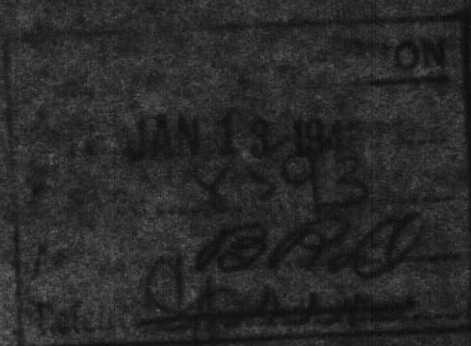
