CHATELS: On his declaration to the Custodian on May 11th, 1942, Tatsuo HAYASHI declared tools left with Mr. P. Sladey, Egmont, B.C. He has written to Mr. Sladey asking him to ship the tools as per letter on file from the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, dated October 29th, 1945. On November 5th, 1945, Mr. Sladey was advised by this office that he had our permission to ship the tools, but was cautioned that shipping charges in connection with this shipment would not be paid by this office as Mr. Tatsuo HAYASHI had no funds to his credit in this office.

BANK ACCOUNT: Tatsuo HAYASHI declared an account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings Streets, Vancouver, B.C., in the sum of \$1100.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: The above declared a life insurance policy with the Crown Life Insurance Co., policy no. 273597, in the amount of \$1000.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: The file reveals that the above surrendered a Carl Zeiss-Ikon Jeanette folding camera to the R.C.M.P. This camera was handed over to the B.C. Security Commission on April 27th, 1943, for shipment to Tatsuo HAYASHI. Full details of this given on Specified Articles summary.

Dear Sir:

We were advised by the Department of Labour, Japanese Division that you wished the box of tools you had left with Mr. Sladey of Egmont, B. C., shipped to you at your present address. We have written to Mr. Sladey and advised him that it will be quite in order for him to ship the tools, with the provision that the shipping expenses must either be prepaid or the tools sent C. O. D.

On reviewing your file we note that other than the tools mentioned above you did not declare any other personal property in the Protected Area.

You declared an account in the Royal Bank of Canada. This did not come under the control of the Custodian. You also declared an insurance policy No. 273597, with the Crown Life Insurance Company in the amount of \$1000.00. This policy remained in your own possession.

Your file reveals that you surrendered a Carl Zeiss-Ikon Jeanette folding camera to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police on March 18th, 1942. This camera was handed over to the British Columbia Security Commission on April 27th, 1943, for shipment to you.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
