This 21-year old Logger from Cumberland signed a Custodian "JP" Declaration form on the 11th May, 1943. He was evacuated on the

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Personal Property: He declared that no chattels were left in the protected areas of British Columbia.

Specific Articles: None.

Bills Receivable: Refund of 15% wage deductions made during the period, January/June, 1941, was collected by this office and remitted to evacuee on the 21st August, 1943, in the sum of \$5.15.

Proportionate share of the liquidated assets of the Royston Saving Association was collected by this office and remitted to evacuee on the 1st August, 1943, in the sum of \$63.04.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: He declared Victory Bonds (\$150.00) and War Savings Certificates (\$45.00) to be in his possession and these were so left.

Bank Accounts: No action was taken by this office with regard to a balance (\$300.00) declared to be in an account with the Cumberland branch of the Royal Bank of Canada.

Life Insurance: No action was taken by this office with regard to a policy for \$1,000.00 with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company.

Liabilities: There are no claims recorded in this file.

Funds: None.
