



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 11, 1942. He was evacuated on September 4, 1942. In his declaration he reported the following assets:

Securities: War Savings Certificates \$20.00, in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Insurance: Mutual Life Insurance Co. policy, in declarant's possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian

In addition to the assets declared, the following are revealed in this file:

Vessel: Funds in the amount of <sup>422.21</sup> \$422.21, received from the sale of the vessel, transferred to Genichiro NAKAHARA from Ichinosuke NAKAHARA in October, 1941, prior to the latter's departure for Japan, were held in Enemy Account on account of Foreign Exchange Control Board regulations. As the Board has advised that no objection will be made to the release of these funds to Genichiro NAKAHARA, the funds have been transferred from Enemy Account to the account of this man.

Accounts Receivable: Refund of expenses incurred in returning to Nanaimo from Steveston in December, 1941, after having delivered the vessel "I.N."/"G.N." to the impounding area in the Fraser, was paid to this office by the Dominion Government, and credited to the account of Genichiro NAKAHARA, in amount of \$10.35.

This file reveals no other personal property of any kind.

MEMORANDUM: File 673

October 27, 1944

Re: Genichiro NAKAHARA, Reg. 08774

The fishing vessel "I.N.", Licence New Westminster 1830, was transferred from Ichinosuke NAKAHARA, who returned to Japan on November 1, 1941, to his son, Genichiro NAKAHARA, in October 1941.

Genichiro NAKAHARA had the vessel re-licensed under New Westminster Licence 3362.

The transfer of title was not recognized by the Custodian.

This vessel was sold for the sum of \$550.00. This sum, less costs, was credited to the account of Ichinosuke NAKAHARA, Japan.

Enemy File 283-51 deals with this vessel.

Upon conferring with Mr. E. N. Johnston of the Foreign Exchange Control Board, Mr. F. G. Shears has advised that the Board has no objection to releasing moneys, in cases such as this, to the resident. The transaction was closed prior to the outbreak of war and the boat may be considered to be the property of the son and funds made available to him.

Accordingly, the sum of \$422.21 being the net proceeds from the sale of this vessel was transferred to Genichiro NAKAHARA on December 12, 1945.

Expenses in the amount of \$127.79 covered the out-of-pocket expenses of this department in connection with wharfage, insurance, watchmen's wages, advertising and survey for valuation purposes by an experienced marine surveyor. We regret that we did not make this clear in our previous letter.

Enclosed herewith is Custodian cheque in the amount of \$432.56, representing all the funds standing to your credit with this office.

Your file has been reviewed and it has been noted that in your declaration to the Custodian on May 11, 1942, you reported War Savings Certificates and a life insurance policy, both in your own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The vessel, which was licensed in your name under New Westminster Licence No. 3362, was sold by the Custodian for the net sum of \$422.21. These funds have been held due to Foreign Exchange Control Board regulations governing the transfer of assets of persons leaving this country, but we have today received a ruling which permits us to credit your account with this money. The sum of \$422.21 has accordingly been placed in your account.

Your account has also been credited with the sum of \$10.35. This was a refund of expenses incurred by you in returning to Nanaimo after delivering your fishing vessel to Naval Service at Steveston in December, 1941.

Your credit balance therefore amounts to \$432.56, which is being remitted to you by the enclosed cheque.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area of British Columbia which vested in the Custodian and, in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
