





CHATELS:

Mrs. HONDO declared on May 18th, 1942 that she left certain effects at 19th Avenue, R. R. #1, Haney, B. C. This house was occupied by her Mother, Shinobu SHIMOJI, File 8705. Masako HONDO was evacuated on September 22nd, 1942. Our fieldmen on October 15th, 1943 inventoried the effects found on the property, only 7 items however, were identified as belonging to Mrs. HONDO and these were acknowledged by her on January 2nd, 1943.

The premises in which Mrs. HONDO'S effects were located at 136 19th Avenue, Haney was on land owned by Mrs. SHIMOJI'S son, Kiyoharu SHIMOJI, File 9327 and according to a memo on file 9327 dated March 12th, 1943, Mrs. SHIMOJI reported on September 9th, 1942 that the house was vacant.

It remained so until May 1943 and during this vacancy was stripped clean of chattels of any value. The police were notified of this and other cases of pilfering on several occasions but no apprehension in this particular case was made.



Dear Madam:

In reviewing your file it is noted that you declared having left certain effects in the house occupied by your mother, Mrs. Shinobu SHIMOJI, 19th Avenue, Haney, B. C.

These were inventoried and acknowledged by you on January 2nd, 1943. However, our records reveal that the house remained untenanted until May 1943 and during this time considerable pilfering occurred in this neighborhood. The police were notified of this from time to time but owing to the area involved it was impossible to control this condition.

During our liquidation of Japanese effects in accordance with the Federal Government's provisions the house on 19th Avenue was examined and it was found that nothing of value remained stored there.

Your file reveals a claim made against you by Y. Horiuchi in the amount of \$5.50. This was not acknowledged by you.

Under the circumstances referred to above we are now closing your file.
