Mrs. HONDO declared on May 18th, 1942 that she left certain effects at 19th Avenue, R. R. #1, Haney, B. C. This house was occupied by her Mother, Shinobu SHIMOJI, File 8705.

Masako HONDO was evacuated on September 22nd, 1942. Our fieldmen on October 15th, 1943 inventoried the effects found on the property. Only 7 items however, were identified as belonging to Mrs. HONDO and these were acknowledged by her on January 2nd, 1943.

The premises in which Mrs. HONDO'S effects were located at 136 19th Avenue, Haney was on land owned by Mrs. SHIMOJI'S son, Kiyoharu SHIMOJI, File 9327 and according to a memo on file 9327 dated March 12th, 1943, Mrs. SHIMOJI reported on September 9th, 1942 that the house was vacant.

It remained so until May 1943 and during this vacancy was stripped clean of chattels of any value. The police were notified of this and other cases of pilfering on several occasions but no apprehension in this particular case was made.
