The above-mentioned Japanese declared a number of articles in his 'JP' Form dated March 28th 1942, left at 307 Ewen Avenue. Investigation after he was Evacuated showed that nothing was left on the premises except the sewing machine bought and paid for by the tenant.

Mrs. Mariko ONISHI declared in her 'JP' Form dated May 9th 1942, leaving a few articles with her mother, Mrs. Geichiro NAGAMATSU, at Pitt Meadows, B. C. From the evidence on file it would seem that all effects were removed by Mrs. ONISHI from 307 Ewen Avenue, leaving the following at her mother's home.

Brown Enamel Steel Bed  
Spring for Same  
Baby's pen  
Cardboard Box of men's effects.

The bed and spring were shipped to Mrs. ONISHI at New Denver in December of 1943. There is no record of the remaining goods on either her mother's or father's file, and disposition of same is not shown on above files.

There were some old effects left on the Surrey property, however, they were not worth moving.

There were also some chattels left at 315 Stanley Street, which property was leased to Mr. Philip Shukowsky. The tenant also had the use of the following chattels:

We have information on our files to the effect that the insured, Eiichi Onishi, policy 11 327 009, and Mrs. Mariko Onishi, policy 11 356 812, are at the present time in an evacuation camp at Harris Farm, New Denver, British Columbia.

These policies lapsed for the non-payment of the November 1943 premiums and both insured are now applying for reinstatement of the insurance. Before acting on these applications, kindly advise us whether we can proceed at this time with the same, or whether the request should be deferred.

We might inform you that \$31.03 on policy 11 327 009 and \$27.44 on policy 11 356 812 is being held by Mr. William Mann, Superintendent of our office at 510 Hastings St. W. cor. Richards St., Vancouver, B. C., who is awaiting instructions.

Your husband declared a few articles of household furniture and effects to be left at 307 Ewen Avenue. Investigation after he was evacuated showed that nothing was left on the premises except the sewing machine bought and paid for by the tenant. Your husband subsequently advised us on September 21st that you and your daughter had moved to Pitt Meadows after his evacuation and he did not know what you had done with the furniture and effects declared.

We see from your registration of May 9th that you declared the furniture was registered in your husband's name and that a baby crib, play chair and play pen were to be left with your mother at Pitt Meadows. Would you please give us your mother's full name and advise what, if anything, you left behind in the restricted area of British Columbia and where you left it in order that we may take the necessary steps.
