On December 4/42 our fieldmen, Messrs Carlson and Anderson inventoried the chattels, and later a further inventory was made by Mr. Moryson, of this office, on February 24/43. This second inventory shows only about one third of the number of articles appearing on that of December 4/42. No comments are on file regarding the differences. Mr. Moryson valued the chattels at "approximately \$25.00" and


