The above Japanese registered with this office on the 8th May, 1942, and at that time he stated leaving furniture for an eight-room house. On the 28th January, 1944, he sent an itemized list of goods left in the care of the tenant, Mr. Sorenson. A number of these chattels however, it was found, were sold to Mr. Sorenson by YOSHIDA on his evacuation. All saleable goods were removed and sold by public auction on the 6th April, 1944 for the net sum of \$56.18. It is noted on the file at that time that all chattels were not removed to auction, but it was later decided the remaining few were not worth the expense of moving.
