

We submitted the above claim to NAKANISHI for payment and it was not disputed by him, but a payment was dependent apparently upon the outcome of the Supreme Court action against two other Japanese for damages suffered by the infant child, Joji, of NAKANISHI.

Messrs. Norris and MacLennan, Barristers, handled the case which was completed April 24th, 1942. In this action they claim for hospital expenses and doctors bills. Judgment in the case was not handed down until September 24th, 1943, and unfortunately for NAKANISHI the decision was against him and in favour of the Defendants. The costs etc. amount to \$741.50 and are payable by NAKANISHI.

In view of the foregoing and of the fact of other substantial claims against him on file, the prospects are far from bright as to payment of this account.

He has no funds with the Custodian and has declared no assets.

We are enclosing herewith copy of Judgment dismissing this action with costs and Allocatur showing the costs having been taxed at \$741.50. Under the Judgment and Allocatur the costs are payable not by the infant plaintiff but by his next friend and co-plaintiff, Kaneichi Nakanishi; also these costs are awarded to the Defendants but the costs are in fact the property of Royal Plate Glass and General Insurance Company of Canada. The Royal Plate Glass Company insured a car owned by one Defendant and driven by the other, whereby the Defendants were indemnified against public liability, and the insuring company undertook to defend any such action. The Insuring Company did undertake the defence of this action, has paid the costs and succeeded in the defence. Therefore, if there are any monies of Kaneichi Nakanishi which are available for his creditors we would be obliged if this sum would be paid out therefrom to the Insuring Company.
