

A trunk was sold in Auction Vancouver 57 for the net sum of \$0.59 and was credited to Tomokichi KOMIYAMA, File 8757, to whom it has been found not to belong.

The only information available is that the trunk was found at 992 Powell St., marked T. KOMIYAMA. Three persons of that name are on our files. One of them had no chattels, the second, Takahiko, File 2300, declared chattels which were moved to 992 Powell St. and sold by Auction and the third, Tomokichi, mentioned above, declared no chattels.

Takahiko KOMIYAMA declared a trunk which does not appear to have been sold or shipped and is therefore being credited with the sum of \$0.59.


The file reveals that the above did not own any specified articles.
