



This is to advise you that we have to-day received \$3.50 from the Union Oil Co. of Canada, Ltd. They inform us that this amount represents a credit balance in your favour on the books of the company. It has been placed to the credit of your account with the Custodian.

We notice on looking over your file that there is a claim of \$15.81 lodged against you by the Brackman-Ker Milling Co. We wrote to you in this connection on the 4th of May.

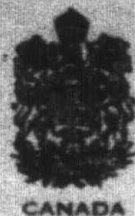
