

This is a small fruit farm with dwelling, woodshed and bath house. This property had an area of 12.537 acres and according to KOBAYASHI' report the cultivated portion was planted to the following crops: strawberries, raspberries, gooseberries, fruit trees. While there is no official report on this place, there is a photo of the house and woodshed with the following memo attached. This house is in poor condition. Finished outside with unpainted cedar siding. Interior just plain unpainted boards". "There has been a lot of sickness in this house and the people living in the District are complaining. They insist on the Custodian Office either fumigating or destroying the building. This house is a detriment as husband and wife have died of T.B. and the son is now infected".

HISTORY OF ADMINISTRATION: This property was leased by Kintaro KOBAYASHI, 29th April, 1942 to Ming Sum for 9 months from 1st April, 1942 with option to extend lease under arrangement with P.C.U. Consideration \$200.00 paid. 1943 ren to be \$100.00. This lease was replaced by one No. 484 granted to Fay Soon by the Custodian 13th April, 1943 for a term of 82 months from 15th April, 1943 to 31st December, 1943. Consideration - \$50.00.

CHATTELS: The above Japanese registered with this office on the 11th May, 1942, at which time he declared leaving some household furniture, farm equipment, garden and carpenters tools on his property at Whonnock.

The property was inventoried on the 7th December, 1942, by our fieldmen, and it was noted that a sewing machine and two beds that he had declared were missing. It is assumed that KOBAYASHI either took these with him or disposed of them prior to his evacuation, as he did not reply to our enquiry, and his house was well boarded and securely locked when our fieldmen inspected it. The chattels inventoried were of very low value, and complaints from the neighbours that the house should be fumigated or destroyed were received, so all chattels were abandoned.

BONDS & INVESTMENTS:

Although he did not declare so, it is noted on file that

KOBAYASHI is a shareholder in the Riverside Lumber Company.

These shares however were not brought under control by the

Custodian.

According to the Pacific Co-operative Union records, KOBAYASHI was the owner of \$90.00 worth of redeemable shares and \$170.00 worth of unredeemable shares. The former shares have been redeemed as follows:-
