



Dear Madam:

Your enquiry regarding real property at Whonnoek, in which you had a half interest with your husband, has been forwarded to us through the Department of Labour.

Prior to your evacuation you made no arrangements regarding the leasing of this property, and we were unable to find a tenant for it during the period when it was under our administration, and therefore, no rentals accrued to the credit of either yourself or your husband at this office.

In accordance with the policy of liquidation decided upon by the Canadian Government, the property was sold to the Director of Veterans' Land Act as of the 1st January, 1943, for the sum of \$344.00. From this sum the following charges were paid:-

Land Registry Office fees	\$3.00
Certificate of Encumbrance	1.00
Legal fees in connection with the conveyance of the property	15.00
Payment of tax arrears (1942)	<u>26.17</u>

leaving the net credit from the property of \$298.83. These funds were credited to the joint account in the name of yourself and your husband. When registering with this office you declared you had a half interest in this jointly owned property and therefore, the net proceeds were divided between yourself and your husband, your share being \$149.42. This sum is credited to your personal account here and will be made available to you in accordance with Government Regulations relative to those persons returning to Japan, of which you no doubt are already well aware.
