
Mrs Hideo (Tadako) KONDO declared on May 11th 1942, that she left 2 beds, kitchen utensils and 10 pipes at her mother's house, Mrs. Chosaburo IINUMA, file 8801, River Road, Ruskin, B. C. She was evacuated on October 13th 1942.

An inventory of effects was found on this property by our fieldmen and is on this file under date of December 9th, 1942. The ownership of the goods listed is given on the original pencil list as Mrs. T. KONDO, but her mother's file contains a complete list of effects found in the house and it is assumed would include Mrs. KONDO'S effects.

The proceeds from sale of chattels removed from Mrs. Chosaburo IINUMA'S house have been credited to her account, file 8801, as the Custodian is unable to determine the respective ownerships.

There are no other assets belonging to Mrs. KONDO revealed on this file and no further administration is required.






