The only asset declared by the above Japanese was a Sun Life Insurance policy, but this was not brought under control by the Custodian.


NAKANO did not declare any liabilities, but two claims were filed against him:

NAKANO denied the first claim, and this was discovered to be against another Japanese, he also stated that he had no recollection of the second claim. M. Ebisuzaki was notified of this, and no further action was taken by them.
