Re: Juji MATSUI (Deceased) #07462

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 12, 1942, in which he reported \$15.00 in War Savings Certificates in his mother's possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$2.22 received from the Provincial Government as refund of 1% wage deductions for 1941. On April 29, 1946, this amount was transferred to the Department of Labour to be applied against funeral expenses of this man who died on November 16, 1942.

Although this man declared no property of any kind on July 2, 1942, he requested a box of tools left at Oda's camp, Port Alberni. Lacking information to the contrary we assume this was sent to him.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

From our files on the family, which include  
the father, mother and eldest brother, there would appear  
to be very few assets. The deceased has a credit balance  
of \$2.22, the father has a credit balance of \$3.65, the  
mother has nothing and the eldest brother has \$18.79.  
The deceased has no other assets. The father has one  
\$15.00 War Saving Certificate and one \$50.00 Victory Bond  
on which \$8.00 was paid on the 20th of March, 1942. The  
eldest brother John Yoshinori MATSUI, Registration #07463,  
owns a lot and house at Port Alberni, B. C., which he has  
been endeavouring to sell for approximately \$700.00.
