

Re: Etsko FUJINO, Reg. 13448

On May 11th, 1942, the above declared that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in any Protected Area of British Columbia.

However, on April 17th, 1943 she requested the Custodian to collect an account for labour of herself in the amount of \$71.10 and for her father, in the amount of \$30.80 from E. Arkell, Whosbeck, B. C. Her request was submitted to Mr. Arkell on April 22nd, 1943 and nothing further was heard of the matter. We advised Miss FUJINO on January 29th, 1946 that as there was no further correspondence in the matter we assumed it had been settled between the two parties. The file may therefore now be closed.
