

On May 17th, 1942 the above declared that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in any Protected Area of British Columbia.

In a Canadian release dated November 14th, 1942 however, she asked for the shipment of two boxes of utensils from 335 Main Avenue, New Westminster. Articles of her husband's belongings were stored at this place, (Yukawa MATSUDA, File 8473) and it may be assumed that these were the same. The boxes were shipped on January 17th, 1943.

No property was found subsequent to that date belonging to her and the file may therefore now be closed.
