
This 30-year old Housewife, a Japanese National, from Ocean Falls, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 12th May, 1942. She was evacuated on the 4th September, 1942, and repatriated to Japan on the 24th December, 1946, per S.S. "Marine Falcon".

Her husband, Kozo, (File 8907), signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 12th May, 1942. He was evacuated on the 29th June, 1942, and repatriated to Japan on the 24th December, 1946, per S.S. "Marine Falcon".

This file has been reviewed today and discloses no evidence of either assets or liabilities.
