




This claim was acknowledged by KONDO on January 20th, 1943 and at the same time he stated he was unable to pay the debt. TANAKA was advised accordingly.

If the Security Commission pay me more I may be able to pay the debt, but the rate they pay me now is not even enough to bring up my family for a month.
