GENERAL SUMMARY

Assets

The above Japanese declared no assets in the Protected Area and his file reveals none.

Liabilities

Although the above Japanese declared no liabilities, two were filed against him at this office:-

Dr. W.A. Robertson	\$75.00
Royal Columbian Hospital	\$170.80

These accounts were referred to KOBAYASHI, and he replied through the B.C. Security Commission on the 27th June, 1944, acknowledging owing debts to both, but did not know the amounts. Detailed statements of the accounts were obtained from the creditors and sent to him. A reply was received from the B.C. Security Commission on the 14th Dec. 1944, acknowledging them, and attached was a postal note for \$3.00 on account of the debts, and stating that subsequent remittances could be expected. No further payments were made to this office however, and both creditors informed us by telephone that no payments had been received by them direct. The \$3.00 remitted, was paid to Dr. W.A. Robertson on account of his claim and he was advised that he would have to look to KOBAYASHI direct for the balance due. The Royal Columbian Hospital was advised that they also would have to look to their debtor direct for payment of the account.

This file reveals no other assets or liabilities and requires no further administration.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

On the 21st July, 1947, we received cheque in the amount of \$45.00 from the Dept. of Labour, sent to them by KOBAYASHI to apply on his debts, and a further \$5.00 was received 24th July, 1947. This \$50.00 was applied on his two accounts - \$35.18 to the Royal Columbian Hospital and \$14.82 to Dr. Robertson.

Upon reviewing the file of Hajime Kobayashi, deceased, we find that we have, standing to his credit in this office, the sum of \$68.20, being funds derived from the sale of his \$10.00 share in the United Farmers Co-operative Union of Matsic, plus interest paid on this share up to the date of sale.

We have been advised by your sister, Toshiyo, that you, Sosuke and Daley are her brothers and that you are the only living heirs of Hajime Kobayashi, deceased. If this is the case, you are entitled, under Canadian law, to share the estate of your father equally.
