Upon reviewing the file of Hajime Kobayashi, deceased, we find that we have, standing to his credit in this office, the sum of \$68.20, being funds derived from the sale of his \$10.00 share in the United Farmers Co-operative Union of Hatzic, plus interest paid on this share up to the date of sale.

We have been advised by your sister, Toshiyo, that you, Morisuke and Daley are her brothers and that you are the only living heirs of Hajime Kobayashi, deceased. If this is the case, you are entitled, under Canadian law, to share the estate of your father equally. Please advise us if this \$68.20 credit is the only estate left by your father and, if so, whether you wish us to divide these funds equally among you or whether there is some other distribution, mutually agreeable to the heirs, which you wish us to make.
