GENERAL SUMMARY

File 8929

9th July, 1946.

Re: Yasuo Gordon OIKAWA - Reg. No. 13525

The above Japanese registered with this office on the 11th May, 1942, declaring at that time he had no assets or liabilities.

Mitsuo OIKAWA, File 9336, when registering with this office declared he owed the above Japanese, \$550.00. A pro rata distribution of Mitsuo OIKAWA's funds were made to his creditors, in which the above Japanese received his proportion amounting to \$507.76, which he would only accept as part payment of the debt.

The only liability revealed on this file was a claim of \$20.00 by Dr. M. UCHIDA. However the creditor withdrew the account, and no action was taken in the matter.

This file reveals no other assets or liabilities.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

The above Japanese has informed us that he owes you the sum of \$550.00.

In accordance with the Canadian Government's policy of liquidation, all his assets in the Protected Area have been liquidated and the proceeds of same credited to his account. It is now desirable that his liabilities also be settled. However we find that sufficient funds are not on hand with which to make settlement in full. The purpose of this letter is therefore, to ask if you would be prepared to accept the sum of \$507.76, or 92.32% of your claim in full settlement of the debt.

We received your letter of the 22nd May, regarding the debt of \$550.00 that was owing to you by the above Japanese. We note that you refuse to accept the proposed distribution of your debtors funds, as full payment of the debt, and we have therefore, credited your account here with the sum of \$507.76 to be applied on account of the amount owing.

Mitsuro OIKAWA has no further funds or assets at this office, and there is therefore, little likelihood of any further funds coming into his account here, and you will have to look to him direct for the collection of the balance owing to you. His address is Tashme.

We were surprised to note your attitude in not accepting this settlement in full of the account, as the other five creditors who were whites, accepted the pro rata distribution in full of their accounts in view of the circumstances.
