I foresee some difficulty in as much that the Certificate of Title may be missing, as the registered owner is in Japan. Have you searched in the Registry Office for this, or written to the heirs at law to produce such Certificate? I doubt very much if the personal representative will be in a position to convey until he produces the title, or takes the regular course of having the Registrar advertise that a new Certificate will be issued in 30 days by reason of evidence having been produced that the original has been lost.
