
This file reveals no assets or liabilities in the name of the above Japanese person.

If I am unable to locate my own record of wages, I would like to have an itemized statement before I can substantiate their claim.

Due to the fact that I am in excess of \$650.00 in debt as a result of this berry farm, I cannot promise to make any payments on this account until after next fruit season.
