He had signed it & had given the whole cheque to me but unfortunately the Custodian got hold of it. Only now I was told that was temporarily and when needed it will be given to ~~me~~ but maybe that was only to fool us by the look of things. I need the money to ~~for~~ put in my teeth & ^{with} only the above amount it's impossible here ~~or~~ anywhere else. Please send me at least another one hundred if not all of the cheque. I am ruining my health especially the stomach for not

being able to chew the food.
Not only myself but anybody
without teeth will suffer
and you can very well
understand that.

My son, Lewis says he has
written you to send the
money to me. as at your
earliest convenience I wish
to have the above amount
sent without delay.
