PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals that Mrs. TOKUNAGA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. TOKUNAGA, who made her declaration to the Custodian on May 13/42 and was evacuated on June 3/42, declared no chattels. Chattels are declared by her husband, and these are dealt with on his file, 2375.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: Mrs. Hidano IKEDA, mother of Mrs. TOKUNAGA, passed away at New Denver on March 9/46. Mrs. TOKUNAGA was the sole beneficiary. The entire credit of the estate in the sum of \$1173.50 was turned over to the Official Administrator and Mrs. TOKUNAGA will eventually get the balance of this after debts and dues are paid.

VICTORY BONDS She declared two \$50.00 Victory bonds in her own possession and two WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in the name of her child Mari. None of these securities were brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: She declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings, in the sum of \$1500.00. This account was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: She declared an insurance policy with the Prudential Insurance Co., the beneficiary being her husband, Jutaro. This policy was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

We have been advised by the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, that the above named, who prior to evacuation resided at 620 Sealin Drive, Vancouver, B. C., died at New Denver, B. C., on March 9th, 1946, and we are writing to request that you kindly undertake the administration of her Estate.

We are enclosing herewith original letter addressed to you by Mrs. Chisato Tokunaga, daughter of the deceased, together with list of particulars and original Will of the late Mrs. Ikeda.

According to our records, Mrs. Ikeda was a widower and left her surviving the following:

Mrs. Chisato Tokunaga, Daughter, New Denver, B. C.  
Arimoto Ikeda, Son, 21 Roberts St., Hamilton, Ontario

Both Mrs. Ikeda, deceased, and her daughter, Mrs. Tokunaga, are Naturalized Canadians, while Mr. Arimoto Ikeda is Canadian Born.

The only asset of the deceased, of which we have knowledge, is a credit balance with the Custodian, amounting to \$1,173.50, derived from the sale of property known as 620 Sealin Drive, and a mineral claim.
