

Chattels on these files now appear to be satisfactorily covered as on September 17th Hiroshi Omori, the husband, signed that eighteen pieces were all his effects left in the restricted area. It appears clear that the items declared by the wife were identical with these. Everything was originally left at the Inverness Cannery but subsequently moved to the Japanese Hall at Prince Rupert and now shipped to the owners at Minto City.
