We are in receipt of your inquiry regarding your radio.

The radio described in your letter was sold for the sum of \$50.00, expenses amounting to \$7.09 were deducted, leaving a net balance of \$42.91. This sum has been credited to your account.

In all cases, funds received from the sale of radios are held until the radio receipt is received in this office. In the case of this radio, as it was reported by the RCMP under the names of yourself and Tamotsu MAEDA, we would ask you to send us the receipt and also have Mr. Maeda confirm the fact that you are the owner of the radio, and that he has no interest.

When we have received the receipt and Mr. Maeda's confirmation of your ownership, we will send you the radio money.
