Turukichi Kusano, a sum of \$218.10 for service rendered

was a verbal agreement made between the said Kanae Saikusa and my husband, Turukichi Kusano that the former would forward payment to me, Tuyo Kusano. I have made inquiries many times as to when he will be able to pay next but he refuses to mention -- in fact, I don't think he has any intention to pay for he even refuses to talk about it.
