PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 9040

23rd June, 1947.

Re: Jujuiro DOI - Registration No. 07557

CHATELS: The above Japanese registered with the Custodian on the 14th May, 1942, but was not evacuated until the 20th October, 1942. When registering with this office, DOI declared he had been living in a house owned by K. Nishimoto, at Aldergrove, and that he was leaving an unspecified quantity of Household furniture and farm implements there. Our fieldmen inspected the property and inventoried the chattels on the 11th November, 1942. A copy of our inventory was sent to DOI who acknowledged it as being correct on the 2nd December, 1942.

On the 19th January, 1944, our fieldman reported regarding 2 gas engines on NISHIMOTO's property to the effect that DOI had sold them. On the 29th February, 1944, we wrote to NISHIMOTO (File 3955), regarding this matter and asking for a confirmation. No reply was received to our letter however, and it is assumed that sales were made by DOI with NISHIMOTO's permission.

On the 17th May, 1944, all saleable chattels belonging to DOI, that could be found on the property were sold by Public Auction at Abbotsford, for the net sum of \$16.22. A considerable quantity of effects were abandoned on the property as not being worth the expense of handling, while a few items were also found to be missing.

BANK ACCOUNT: DOI declared he had a bank account at Vancouver, but this was not brought under control by the Custodian.

This file reveals no other personal property assets.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

We are writing to you in connection with two of your engines left behind in the protected area.

Our information is that you negotiated with a Mr. E. Seagrist for the purchase of one engine but finally turned the offer down. After your evacuation an ex-employee of yours, Junjiro Doi, accepted Mr. Seagrist's offer with the understanding that when you returned, the engine could be purchased back by you at the original selling price of \$90.00. We have no objection to this transaction but should be grateful for your confirmation that Mr. Doi had your authority.

The second engine, being a large donkey engine, was apparently sold to a Mr. Rudy Johnston and Sam Dragon, also apparently by Mr. Doi. Is this deal also in order?

R E P O R T

On Nishimoto's inventory there was listed two gas engines. On preparing this property for auction, I found only one engine, that being a large Donkey Engine partially dismantled.

Upon investigation, I found that a Mr. E. Seagrist had purchased the motor that was missing. Mr. Seagrist negotiated with Nishimoto for the purchase of same but the offer was turned down. However, after he was evacuated, H. Doi who was somehow connected with the property, accepted Mr. Seagrist's offer with the understanding that when Nishimoto and he returned, the motor could be purchased back at the original selling price of \$90.00.

I understand that a Mr. Rudy Johnston and Sam Dragon made a deal on the large motor. I was told they had been taking parts from it. Mr. Dragon's wife knew nothing of the transaction and as Mr. Dragon is in the trucking business, I had some difficulty in finding him.

It seems that Mr. Doi made several transactions with people in the neighbourhood and yet Nishimoto declared none. I wonder if Doi was selling with Nishimoto's permission?

NISHIMOTO owns certain lands shown on 3955. There is a note on this file stating that DOI claims an interest in the land. There is a note to the same effect on 9040.

There is no search on either file nor any certificate of encumbrance, but the vesting certificate on 3955 does not refer to any interest in DOI.

Inquiry should be made of NISHIMOTO and DOI as to whether this interest really exists. If it is found to exist, NISHIMOTO must be regarded as a Trustee for DOI to the extent of the interest.

The files indicate that the parties lived on the same land, DOI having a dwelling house and barn of his own on the NISHIMOTO property, NISHIMOTO having used a different set of buildings.
