GENERAL SUMMARY

August 30, 1946.

Re: Notoharu HATTORI, #07849

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 14, 1942. He was evacuated, according to R.C.M.P. information, on March 11, 1942, but this appears to be incorrect.

In his declaration he reported a bank account in the Bank of Montreal with a balance of approximately \$500.00, and a bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada with a balance of approximately \$1,000.00. These accounts did not come under the control of this office.

He reported a \$1,000.00 policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co., a \$200.00 policy with the Prudential Life Insurance Co. in the name of one child and another \$200.00 policy with the Prudential Life Insurance Co. in the name of another child. These did not come under the control of this office. He reported a \$2,000.00 policy with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. On October 31, 1944, a cheque for \$141.69 was forwarded to HATTORI, through this office, being the cash surrender value of this policy.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
