In reply to your memorandum of the 24th instant.

Nothing was ever entered in our records.

Mr. Saunders of the B. C. Security Commission brought in some chattels from Woodfibre just before his departure for the interior. He asked us to hold them temporarily as he intended to ship them up country. He did not do so and it is possible that NAKANO's chattels may be included but without identification. It will be necessary to wait until most of the chattels have been liquidated in 992 and by the process of elimination, we may be able to find his things.
